

## Remembering Eucharist

The word "Eucharist" means 'thanksgiving'.

If this is True, put the letter D in space 1, if it is False put the letter A in that space.

Before sitting down for the meal that we refer to as the Last Supper the disciples washed each other's feet.

If this is True, put the letter S in space 2, if it is False put the letter O in that space.

3. During the Liturgy of the Eucharist we recall Jesus's last meal before he died.

If this is True, put the letter T in space 3, if it is False put the letter G in that space.

4. The last meal Jesus ate was a called "Passover", which recalled a time when the first-born of the Israelites, were spared when the destroying angel passed over Egypt.

If this is True, put the letter H in space 4, if it is False put the letter I in that space.

5. The Apostles who joined Jesus at the Last Supper were Andrew, Anthony, Bartholomew, James the Greater, James the Lessor, John, Jude, Matthias, Matthew, Peter, Philip, Simon and Thomas.

If this is True, put the letter F in space 5, if it is False put the letter I in that space.

6. While they were eating, Jesus took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to his disciples, saying, "Take and eat; this is my body."

If this is True, put the letter S in space 6, if it is False put the letter T in that space.

7. Jesus took a cup of wine, gave thanks and offered it to his disciples and said "Drink from it, all of you. This is my blood."

If this is True, put the letter I in space 7, if it is False put the letter O in that space.

8. During the Passover meal, the Jewish people eat "unleavened bread".

If this is True, put the letter N in space 8, if it is False put the letter F in that space.

9. Some of the Apostles did not drink the wine because they preferred water.

If this is True, put the letter S in space 9, if it is False put the letter M in that space.

10. Since the death of Jesus, Jewish families do not celebrate Passover.

If this is True, put the letter P in space 10, if it is False put the letter E in that space.

11. When the priest says, "Peace be with you" during the Liturgy of the Eucharist, we remember Jesus's last words before he died.

If this is True, put the letter I in space 11, if it is False put the letter M in that space.

12. We recite the "Our Father" during the Liturgy of the Eucharist because we remember this great prayer that Jesus gave to us.

If this is True, put the letter O in space 12, if it is False put the letter R in that space.

13. Jesus is one part of the Trinity.

If this is True, put the letter R in space 13, if it is False put the letter I in that space.

14. A priest is the only person who can offer communion to you.

If this is True, put the letter T in space 14, if it is False put the letter Y in that space.

15. During the Liturgy of the Eucharist we remember the time when Jesus was born.

If this is True, put the letter I in space 15, if it is False put the letter O in that space.

16. The disciples were very sad because they understood that Jesus would die the next day.  
If this is True, put the letter N in space 16, if it is False put the letter F in that space.
17. We believe that during the Liturgy of the Eucharist bread and wine are changed into the  
Body and Blood of Christ. This is called transubstantiation.  
If this is True, put the letter M in space 17, if it is False put the letter U in that space.
18. Only gold vessels may hold the blessed bread and wine.  
If this is True, put the letter S in space 18, if it is False put the letter E in that space.

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
